DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Apply up to 1 1/3 quarts of Thionex 3EC in a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre by air or in a minimum of 25 gallons of water per acre by ground.
- Apply when insects first appear.

RESTRICTIONS / PRECAUTIONS

- Do not make more than 2 applications per season.
- Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.
- All alfalfa seed screenings shall be disposed of in such a way that they cannot be distributed or used for human food or animal feed. The seed conditioner shall keep records of screening disposal for three years from the date of disposal and shall furnish the records to the WSDA immediately upon request. Conditioner disposal records shall consist of documentation of on-farm disposal, disposal at a controlled dumpsite, incinerator, composter, or other equivalent disposal site and shall include the lot numbers, amount of material disposed of, the growers(s), and the date of disposal.
- No portion of the alfalfa seed plant, including but not limited to green chop, hay, pellets, meal, whole seed, cracked seed, roots, bulbs, leaves and seed screenings may be used or distributed for food or feed purposes.
- Alfalfa seed shall bear a tag or container label which forbids the use of the seed for human consumption or animal feed.
- Alfalfa seed may not be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.
- For use under this SLN label do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
- This product is toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or broadleaf weeds. Do not apply the 1 1/3 qt./acre (1 lb. ai/acre) rate of this product to blooming alfalfa seed: apply as a pre-bloom or post-bloom spray only. Applications of the 1 1/3 pt./acre (0.5 lb. ai/acre) rate of this product to blooming alfalfa seed must be timed to coincide with periods of minimum bee activity, between late evening and midnight. Alfalfa leafcutting bees may be killed as a result of applications to blooming alfalfa seed, even if all precautions are followed.
- This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Thionex 3EC must not be used where impact on listed threatened or endangered species is likely. You may contact the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife, National Marine Fisheries Service or US Fish & Wildlife Service for information on

listed threatened or endangered species. Consult the federal label for additional restrictions and precautions to protect aquatic organisms.

- Due to risk of runoff and drift, do not apply within a distance of 300 feet of lakes, ponds, streams, and estuaries.

WSDA CONTAINER DISPOSAL GUIDANCE

- Pesticide containers must be properly cleaned prior to disposal. The best time to clean empty pesticide containers is during mixing and loading, because residue can be difficult to remove after it dries. Triple rinse (or pressure rinse) the pesticide container, empty all pesticide rinse water into the spray tank, and apply to a labeled crop or site. Recycling cleaned containers is the best method of container disposal. Information regarding the recycling of empty and cleaned plastic pesticide containers in Washington is available on the internet from WSU at <http://pep.wsu.edu/waste/wd.html> or from WSDA at <http://agr.wa.gov>. Cleaned containers may also be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, if permitted by the county. Burning is not a legal method of container disposal in Washington.
